

SBST COMMITTEE POLICY

- 1. Every teacher is the member of the committee.
- 2. Teachers are to identify learners with specific learning barriers in the first term of every year.
- 3. Identified learners in the previous year must be monitored for their progress.
- 4. Any identified learner must be involved in the progress of learner.
- When a learner is to be referred to the SBST stirring committee the parent and the identifying teacher must be involved.
- 6. The referral forms must be filled with full details of the barrier the learner is experiencing.
- 7. SBST committee will then provide a program to the learner to monitor learner progress.
- 8. If the learner shows no progress then the parent must be informed and the SBST must be involved.
- 9. The SBST then will organize a programme for the learner.
- 10. If no progress in evident then the psychologist will be involved together with the parent.
- 11. The learner will be referred to the right institution for him or her to develop and progress.
