BUILDING GROUND & MAINTENANCE POLICY

AIM:

This policy is aimed at:

 The establishment of an effective system of grounds duty performed by educators and perfects in order to ensure the safety of learners before school and during breaks.

METHOD

- An overall grounds duty coordinator is chosen at a staff meeting at the beginning of the year.
- All educators and prefects are responsible for grounds duty.
- A school plan is developed to indicate where educators and prefects should do ground duty.
- Educators and prefects should report at their respective duty points as soon as possible.
- Educators and prefects should move around in their service area and not take up position in one place.
- Educators and prefects should be placed on duty on specific days when duty should be performed.
- A grounds duty convener should be appointed for each day of the term.
- Educators and prefects report to the grounds duty convener.
- The ground duty convener should ensure that educators and prefect actually do their duty.
