Learner pregnancy policy

(Guided by SASA no: 84 of 1996 and constitution of RSA Act no 108 of 1996).

Our commitment

- The school will never allow discrimination against pregnant learners.
- Their dignity will be protected and be treated with respect.

Role players and their responsibility learners.

Must:

- Disclosed pregnancy to parents, school or trusted person.
- Be prepared to undergo some form of tests either at clinic or hospital.
- Willingly attend classes and clinic.
- Dress in respectful way or manner.
- Never discuss pregnant experiences, feelings or any sexual contact resulting to pregnancy to other learners at school.

Parents.

Must:

- When the learner is 7 months pregnant the parents should come to school and take care of the child.
- Report pregnancy to the school in writing
- Be prepared to take the learners to the clinic for test.
- Allow the school to Act on his/her behalf in absentia.
- Be prepared to pay for service rendered.
- Give support to teach sex education.
- Parents must be encouraged to disclose if their children are pregnant.

The school.

They are not allowed to be given pills or any kind of medicines - Pads

Must:

- Teach life orientation.
- Give sex education.
- Develop youth clubs/activities. Eg love life.
- Invite health department and other NGO'S.

- Offer counselling.
- Request for pregnancy confirmation in writing from the clinic for record purpose.
- Allow pregnant child to attend school and sit for exams.
- Have close relationship with parents.
- Report such matters to DOE (Department of education).
