



SCHOLAR PATROL POLICY

The policy is influenced by scholar patrol manual, compiled by the Directorate, Traffic safety.

Organization

- Teachers under safety committee must serve in scholar patrol
- The number should be formally appointed for a period of two years. It should compromise of a leader and 3members

Equipment

- Caps
- Lapel badges
- Whistle
- Stop sign poles
- Stop sign boards

Registration

- The crossing must be registered as all other scholar patrol crossings
- The school traffic authority and local directorate must sign the registration form.

Condition of use

- A scholar patrol may only do duty at a registered crossing.
- Members should either stand on the shoulder of the road or as indicated by the traffic authority.
- Members may under no circumstance move into the street/road to stop the traffic or regular it. NB proper supervision, storage and maintenance of patrol equipment is a sole responsibility of the school.

Parents / guardian

Parents of prospective members should:

- Fillin and sign consent form SP2 before pupils are allowed to fake part.

Full responsibility of teachers.

- At two point should learners be left alone to patrol without supervision.
- A record book must be kept and issued on request.
- A report to the principal safety committee must be tabled for nay dangers.
- No learner should be allowed to cross the road except at the pedestrian crossing or demarcated area.
